

THE NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF a Motion by New Brunswick Power Distribution and Customer Service Corporation for an Order with Respect to Certain Studies and Information Requests Previously Ordered by the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities

ORDER

The New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (“the Board”) has received a motion from the New Brunswick Power Distribution and Customer Service Corporation (“Applicant”) dated April 4th, 2007.

The motion arises from orders made by the New Brunswick Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the “PUB”) in its decision dated June 19, 2006 on an application for a change in the Applicant’s charges, rates and tolls for services performed within the Province of New Brunswick dated March 21, 2005.

The PUB made orders requiring the Applicant to complete a number of studies and file certain information.

Not all studies have been filed and the above-noted motion is now made by the Applicant for the purpose of seeking directions from the Board with respect to those studies and information.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- a) A Hearing shall be held at the Hilton Trade and Convention Centre, Saint John, New Brunswick, on Tuesday the 15th day of May, 2007 commencing at 9:30 o'clock in the forenoon, and from day-to-day thereafter as required, when and where the Applicant and Intervenors should attend and be prepared to make arguments as to what further action is now required by the Applicant with respect to those studies and information.
- b) That the Motion, the evidence and a copy of the Board’s Order will be placed on file for examination by interested parties during normal business hours in the offices of

this Board and in the Applicant's business offices in New Brunswick, no later than the 24th day of April, 2007.

 - providing the reason for the nature of the proposed intervention and
 - setting out the name of the person and any authorized representative of the person and the mailing address, civic address, email address, telephone number, and any other telecommunications numbers of the person or the person's authorized representative.
